- Discussed tax on transportation Commissioners will decide of millage will sunset or continue. Penny tax may be included with a referendum for trails and parks. Leisure Services has a \$4 million CIP. If millage continues, CIP could be funded through this.
- 2. Discussed multi-modal transportation. Bryan Kirby gave presentation to subcommittee.
- 3. Maps/signs are needed to direct at the missing link in Oviedo and Winter Springs.
- 4. Metro-Plan has money that can be used to pay for road signage for bike lanes. Orlando has language for bike lanes under their growth management plan.
- 5. Brett Blackadar will be invited to March 27 PPAC meeting to present proposed bike lane road signage for Seminole County. Policy for Seminole County does not include bike lane signage, subcommittee would like to know how this could be changed.
- 6. Subcommittee would like to see a list of proposed DOT projects. Will be looking for planned bike lanes.
- 7. Will discuss joint proposal of cities and county to secure funding for bike lane signs from Metro-Plan. Subcommittee would like to hold another summit with the cities to discuss trail plan that was just completed and partnering on road-way bike lanes.
- 8. Subcommittee would like to know if streets are swept on county maintained roadways.
- 9. Bryan Kirby to come up with initial route plan for bikes.
