The meeting was called to order at 7:30 a.m. and the minutes for June 2013 were approved.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Website. A discussion about setting up a trails website independent of the County's website was discussed. John May will be researching third party websites to discuss with subcommittee in August.
2. Barbara Whittier did not agree to the idea of a separate trails website in addition to the county website, which would make it more confusing to the public and there was no vote taken by the subcommittee on establishment of a separate web site and how it will impact the County website Trail information. She stressed that the purpose of our subcommittee is to support the County Trails system and make recommendations to staff.
3. Staff was asked to modify trails map presented to PPAC to include drinking fountains, mountain bike trail, historical markers, parking, add revision date, and contact information for Leisure Services.
4. Subcommittee and bike shops would like an 8 ½ x 11 trail map made available in paper form or a PDF.
5. Subcommittee members asked about signage for paved trails that would direct people to bike shops, restaurants. Staff will discuss possible sponsorships.
6. The subcommittee may participate in the Seminole Cyclefest in November at Melonville Park. Brian Kirby will report back to the subcommittee in August.
