**Previous Minutes** – Quorum did not exist, therefore no minutes to approve.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

- **Trails Update from Engineering -**
  - **Lake Monroe Loop** – Celery and Mellonville areas. CPH consultants studying ROW issues. Other considerations by Subcommittee: Separate bike lane or striping? City of Hollywood Beach has something similar.
  - **Lake Monroe West** – City of Sanford portion on hold for now. Talk about 17-92 becoming City Road and lower speed limit to 35 MPH.
  - **SWT South Extension** – By Lowes working on ROW alignment. Approx 0.7 miles long. Crossing planned on SR 46 by Orange Blvd. To BCC for additional money. Bids at \$644k with 120 day construction about July to November 2016. No trailheads currently planned for Lowes areas or by Bear Lake Road. No bridges or tunnels proposed yet at SR436, SR 434 and SR 46 at Rinehart.
  - **Missing Link Winter Springs** – working on property issues. City of Winter Springs involved too. Mr. Vandenburg wants to help with process.
  - **Flagler Trail** – Engineering looking to replace bridge in future.
  - **I4 Bridge** – is now open but expected to have more work later in year.
  - **Howell Creek Trestle** – to be done within 3 months; Sept. to Nov. 2016.
  - **Rinehart Road sections** – To be done up to SR 46 soon. County will have some sections near public drainage ponds to maintain or Sanford.

**New Business:**

- **Overlook Park** – Trees trimmed and pressure washing 4-14-16.
- **Blueways** – Mr. Durr to present Beta Test Demo to PPAC group. Larger Blueway discussion deferred until more members are present.
- **Adopt a Park** – Brochure to be updated with Leisure Service office and presented at a future date TBD. Will include other elements such as Trails and Boat Ramps.
- **Soldiers Creek Trail** – No funds currently to do improvements although in the long range work program.
- **Bi-Monthly Meetings** – Future Bi-Monthly meeting will be moved up to May 11, 2016 to sync with main PPAC meeting timeframes. Group will vote on amended bi-monthly schedule in May.
