OLD BUSINESS:

- **Trails Update from Engineering -**
 - **Missing Link Winter Springs** – Commissioner Horan sent letter to DEP in Tallahassee to facilitate completion. The Florida Cabinet should have final approval of land agreement in August.

New Business:

- **Adopt-a-Park Program** – Is in process of being rolled out to public and includes Parks, Passive Parks, Boat Ramps, Trails and Natural Lands.
- **Blueways** – Discussion put on hold until Mr. Brewer is present. Mr. Durr to present Beta Test Demo to PPAC group in future.
- **Soldiers Creek Trail Mountain Bike Trail** – No funds currently to do improvements although in the long range work program. Group was wondering if 17-92 and SR 417 parcel would be developed for Mountain Bike trail. Group wants to make sure trails are safe for pedestrians too.
- **Paved Trails** – Group requested information about the prioritization of new bridges and/or tunnels on sections of trails. General “informal” consensus in highest to lowest order is as follows: SR 436 on SWT, SR 434 for SWT, SR 46 and SR 46A. Preliminary Engineering would have to be done and cost estimates prepared.
